Extended Care For students K-8th Grades

CCS has Extended Care available before and after school for enrolled students in grades K-8th for the 2018-2019 school year. We are licensed by the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs. Our hours are 7:30am-8:00am and 3:45pm-5:45pm Monday – Friday. Extended Care in the afternoon is not available on half school days.

Fees:

\$25 annual registration fee per family
\$1.50 per 15 minutes of care (or part thereof)
\$5 per every 5 minutes for late pick-up

Provide a week's notice for homework. Assignments and all tests must be completed upon return. Please do not request work to be provided sooner than the day before the trip's departure. (Exception-Math progress is fairly predictable, and, therefore, Math assignments may be provided in advance of the day before departure.) Vacation homework will be provided on the day before the vacation.
