From the Pastor

A unified church where enemies become siblings is one of the strongest evidences of the truth of the gospel, especially in a world as fragmented and divisive as ours. The church as the body of Christ is an alternative culture where one gives up their rights for the sake of others, loses their lives in order to find them, and denies themselves in order to gain Christ. This kind of unity is Holy Spirit empowered. That is why Paul told the Ephesian church to be "eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" (Eph. 4:3). It's why he wrote to the Corinthians: "I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment" (1 Cor. 1:10). Where division might normally reign, unity should instead lead to an uncommon love, where believers listen to and bear with one another. "By this all people will know that you are my disciples," said Jesus, "if you have love for one another" (John 13:35). Let's be that kind of community; empowered by the Holy Spirit; trusting in His power and might.



From the Field

SHORT TERM MISSION TRIP | BOLIVIA

Over the past 25 years God has been gracious to bring about lasting change in communities, families and individuals

influenced by the word and deed gospel ministry of GATHER Network International. The focus of GATHER is to: (1) Build relationships with impoverished and gospel resistant communities. (2) Teach holistic ministry models, theology by extension, and evangelism. (3) Train nationals to identify, own, and overcome barriers to healthy kingdom living.

In July, Cornerstone had the privilege of sending a short-term mission team to Bolivia for ten days. We participated with Bolivian staff in the work of church and community partnership in the Berlin Zone of Bolivia. We joined together to help build a fence for a church in Dos de Agosto, participate in a workshop on Diabetic health and prevention in El Carmen, and visit Gathers rural development training center. For some members of the team it was their first time being in Bolivia and seeing the work first hand. Others have been making regular visits and were familiar with the work. We also had a few that had been before, but it had been 12-15 years between visits. They could hardly believe their eyes! It is one thing to see pictures and hear reports, but it is another thing to walk the land, see the people, and personally witness the transformation.

Our team was able to visit the Gran Chaco region where we spent time with Alcides, who serves as a community leader and church planter. We visited his church and saw many youth clearing land for a community garden they are initiating. This church is less than five years old and already has about ten families involved and 50 people coming on a Sunday. Remarkable for a community of its size!

Our trip to Bolivia was a fantastic experience. We were blessed by the hospitality and leadership from Renato Reyes del Rio, the Director of GATHER. Please pray for Renato as he directs the ministry and handles administrative tasks including legal and government issues. Renato and his family are a blessing to short term teams that come to serve in Bolivia. We enjoyed spending time with his wife and children, laughing with them and being treated to many Bolivian foods both in his home and throughout the city. It is so helpful having a bi-lingual family offer us their hospitality and care for our needs. Join us some time. You will be well cared for!!
